Many participated in the open house hosted by the committee to discuss parks. The work on the major trails in Mt. Geoffrey Park and the adjacent Crownland has been completed and routine maintenance is on going.

CVRD requested removal of invasive plants from Hidden Beach Park. This is mostly complete, with some finishing touches pending.

Both Hidden Beach and Grassy Point Parks will be surveyed with cedar rail fencing to be installed to mark the boundaries.

The vehicle was removed from the cliff at Summit Trail with ICBC not taking on as much of the cost as we expected.

Jeremy Payne resigned from the committee to pursue a career as a Chef and Tyler Manson was appointed as replacement. We are excited to have him join us.

Reina LeBaron has been the minute taker for the committee and we extend our thanks for her commitment and expertise.

Yana Pethick has been the park maintenance contractor doing the work to keep the trails open and exciting for all users.

No new trails are planned for next year; we will work to bring the existing trails to IMBA and provincial standards.

Bridges in Mt. Geoffrey Nature Park will be equipped with anti skid material. The location of the outhouse at Sandpiper Beach is being discussed by the committee.
