HALL COMMITTEE ANNUAL REPORT - 2014

The Community Hall is probably the busiest multi-purpose building on the Island. Here is a summary of the way it was used this past year:

There were 4 indoor markets, 15 art shows, 12 lunches, 4 dinners, 10 days of Hornby Festival, 6 days of Blues festival. Exercise, yoga, tai chi, and dance classes took up 200 occasions, there were 5 weddings, 10 social events, 10 local music concerts, 64 ping pong events, 6 school events, 50 movie nights, 3 theatre performances, 12 meetings, and concerts, and 4 classical music concerts.

As well there were on average 10 meetings a month in the green room.

That all adds up to over 415 events, ranging from a couple of hours, to a day and an evening. Maintenance is therefore a main concern of the Hall Committee, and for that I want to thank the committee members, the cleaners and handy persons who keep the Hall looking good and in good working order.
