

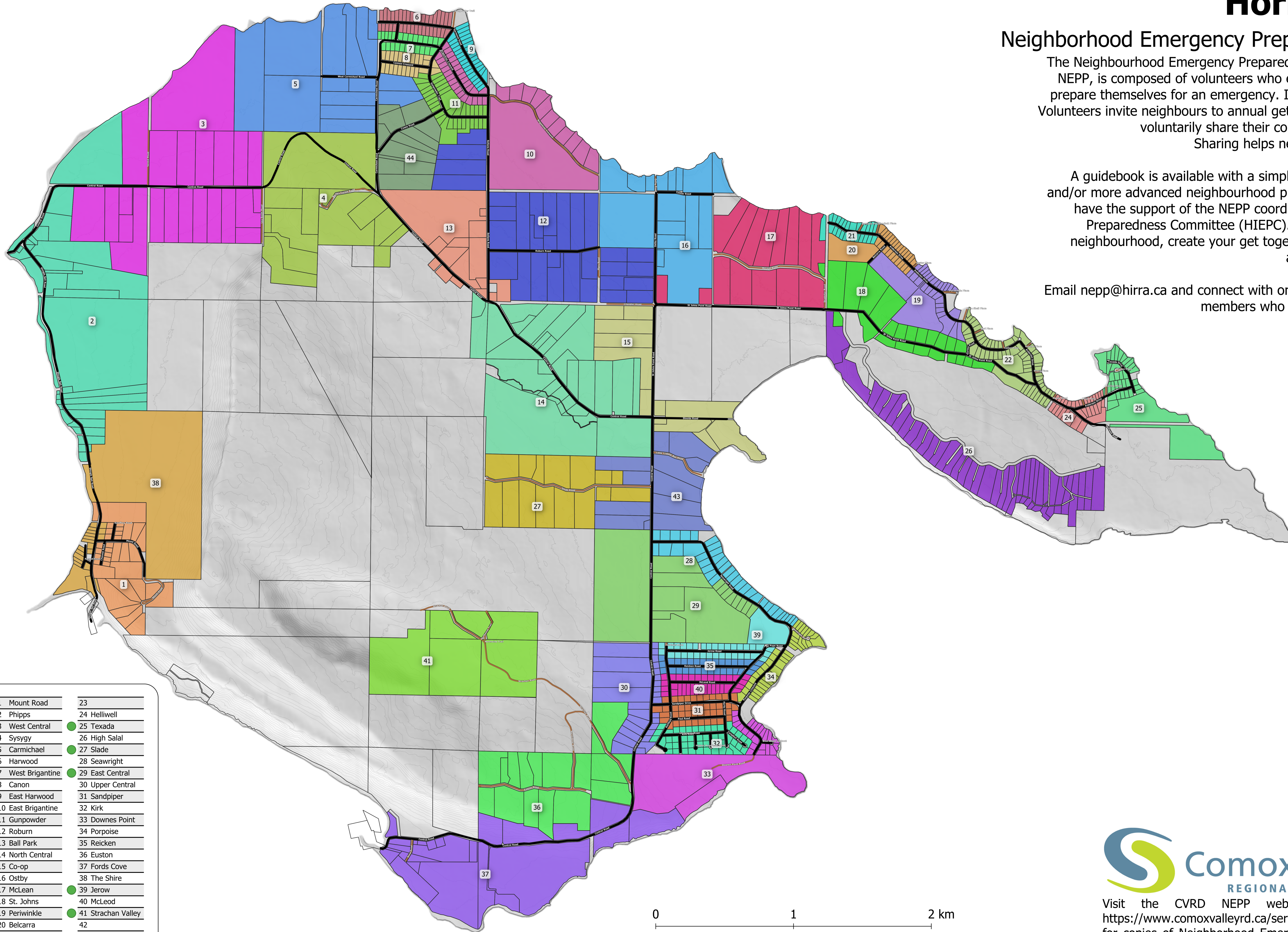
# Hornby Island

## Neighborhood Emergency Preparedness Program

The Neighbourhood Emergency Preparedness Program, also known as NEPP, is composed of volunteers who encourage their neighbours to prepare themselves for an emergency. It is a "grassroots" endeavour. Volunteers invite neighbours to annual get-togethers where people may voluntarily share their concerns, needs, and resources. Sharing helps neighbours support each other.

A guidebook is available with a simple step by step guide for basic and/or more advanced neighbourhood programs. NEPP volunteers will have the support of the NEPP coordinator from the HI Emergency Preparedness Committee (HIEPC).
